

Biographical Sketch of Reverend Robert G. Twyman



Robert Gregory Twyman heard the voice of Jesus calling him into the ministry in 1964 and was licensed by the Greater New Mount Moriah Baptist Church of Detroit, Michigan, where he was also ordained.

After graduating from Cass Technical High School, Detroit, Michigan, he attended the University of Detroit, where he received a Bachelor of Arts Degree and the Master of Divinity degree from Morehouse School of Religion Interdenominational Theological Center, Atlanta, Georgia.

He began his ministerial career as Youth Director of Greater New Mount Moriah and served there as Interim Assistant Minister. He served the Antioch Baptist Church as Assistant to Pastor Cameron Alexander until 1979. He received a call from the Mount Zion Baptist Church, Savannah, Georgia and served there until he answered the call of First Baptist Church Fairfield, Fairfield, Alabama in March 1992.

He serves actively in many ministerial, educational and civic organizations. He has given leadership to religious and community organizations, formerly serving as Chairman, Labor Relations Ministerial Advisory Board of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc. Currently his involvement includes: Moderator, Peace Baptist District Association, Treasurer, Northwest District State Convention, Alabama Baptist State Convention; and board member of the Metro West Ministries. He is active in the Birmingham Baptist Ministers Conference; Peace Baptist District Congress; various levels of work in the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., Fairfield Ministers Alliance.

Reverend Twyman is married to the former Mimi Renee Watson, and they are the proud parents of two sons: Robert Gregory, II and Tristan, and one daughter, Kammarin.
