Course Descriptions

AM Courses:

<u>Course #4014 – The Doctrine of Prayer</u>: Teach on the fundamental purpose, principles, and power of prayer. Understand prayer as the channel of communication of the believer to the Father.

<u>Course #5012 – Becoming an Effective Deacon</u>: Assist the deacon in becoming aware of his biblical base. Ideas are given that will enable them to more effectively perform their duties and work harmoniously with the pastor and other church leaders.

<u>Course #5020 – Conflict Management, NC</u>: Examine basic biblical principles that students may apply to successfully maneuver through various conflicts that frequently arise in the church. Develop a model that can be utilized in conflict resolution.

<u>Course #6013 – Organizing the Church for Christian Education, NC</u>: Focus on the various administrative and organizational skills needed to organize the Christian education department. Emphasis placed on structure, leadership, and staffing needs for Christian education.

Sister Florence Staples – St. Joseph Baptist Church/text – <u>Directing Christian Education (The Changing Role of the</u> <u>Christian Education Specialist)</u>, by Michael Lawson & Robert Choun, Jr.

<u>Course #7012 – Youth Discipleship (course for Youth)</u>, NC: This course is designed to train young people, ages 14-18, to be Christian Educators. Teenagers will be equipped with techniques, methods, strategies, materials, and sharper skills to be effective teachers.

<u>Course #9024 – Technology in the Local Church I, NC</u>: This course will provide an introductory training on how to use the latest technology in Christian ministry. Students will be introduced to presentation apps (PowerPoint and Keynote), database apps (Excel, Numbers, Access) and social media apps (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc.,) and other learning management systems (Thinkific, Google Classroom, etc.).

<u>*Course # 1001 – Introduction to the Bible:</u> Introduce the sixty-six (66) books of the Bible, its origin, and the critical events, periods, and personalities that led to the development of the Bible in its present form. *Course #2022 – Teaching Your Teachers how to Teach: Designed for pastors, deans, Sunday School Superintendents, directors of Christians education and teachers in obtaining helpful and creative methods of teaching staff and students the newest and most innovative methods of communication in the classroom settings.

<u>Course #5014 – The Role of the Minister's Wife, NC</u>: This course is designed to focus on the minister's wife and her responsibilities as a Christian, a mother, a wife, a leader, and a community servant. Sister Terilyn Patterson – Abysinnia Baptist Church/no textbook required.

<u>Course #6005 – Financing and Budgeting the Work of the Church, NC</u>: Provide information critical to the development and operation of a total church budget that integrates the mission, money, and message of the church. Emphasize tithing, corporate management responsibility, planning strategies, and a strong emphasis on immediate needs and long-range goals.
